01. GENERAL INSPECTION ADMINISTRATION 16%

- 0101.** Communicate fire protection and prevention practices.
- 0102.** Respond to inquiries regarding fire and life safety practices.
- 0103.** Prepare inspection reports based on observations conducted in the field.
- 0104.** Conduct research to identify applicable codes or standards given a fire and/or life safety issue.
- 0105.** Identify instances where permits are required, and issue permits.
- 0106.** Maintain records concerning inspections, complaints, and investigative information.
- 0107.** Conduct inspections related to the investigation of complaints.
- 0108.** Provide written correspondence related to the appeals and enforcement process.
