

ICC Ad Hoc Committee on the Administrative Provisions in the I-Codes

Statement of Scope and Objectives

(Approved: April 20, 2005)

COMMITTEE TITLE: Ad Hoc Committee on the Administrative Provisions in the I-Codes

ABBREVIATION: AHC-Admin

SCOPE: The scope of this ad hoc committee activity includes:

1. Reviewing the administrative provisions (Chapter 1 and applicable appendices) in the International Codes for consistency and, where inconsistencies are identified, submitting code change proposals to address such inconsistencies in the next available ICC code development cycle.

2. Review and study of the ICC code development process as it relates to maintenance of the administrative provisions in the I-Codes with a recommendation to the Board of Directors as to the need for an independent code development committee to maintain the administrative provisions of the I-Codes.

PURPOSE: The purpose of this ad hoc committee is to review the administrative provisions in the I-Codes and to correlate those provisions as needed to provide consistent administrative provisions, including the identification of those areas needing code changes to accomplish that correlation.

PRODUCT: The product of this ad hoc committee activity will be code change proposals submitted (Deadline March 26, 2006), as necessary, to the ICC International Codes consistent with the results of the committee's review and study.

The ad hoc committee will also make a recommendation to the ICC Board of Directors concerning the need for a separate code development committee on administrative provisions.

RELATED ACTIVITIES: Monitor the ICC code development process for proposed changes by other parties to provisions within the scope of this effort for consistency with the purpose and objectives of the ad hoc committee.

MEETINGS: One or two meetings are anticipated through February, 2006 at convenient locations that minimize the expense to ICC, with conference calls and electronic correspondence as necessary between meetings.

TIMETABLE: The anticipated completion of the activities of this ad hoc committee will be the conclusion of the 2006/2007 code development cycle.
