2007/2008 PROPOSED CHANGES TO THE INTERNATIONAL ZONING CODE

Proposed changes to the *International Zoning Code* are heard by the International Property Maintenance/Zoning Code Committee. See the tentative order of discussion for the International Property Maintenance Code Committee.

Z1-07/08 109.2.2

Proponent: Brenda James, County of Greenville, SC

Revise as follows:

109.2.2 Time limit. An appeal shall only be considered if filed within 40 20 working days after the cause arises or the appeal shall not be considered. If such an appeal is not made, the decision of the code official shall be considered final.

Reason: This change was forwarded to the Code Correlation Committee Secretary and direction was given that this change would have to be approved by the ICC body.

This change would bring all ICC Codes into uniformity to establish a requirement for a definitive time to file an appeal with the Board of Appeals. This period would be 20 days after the decision or Notice from the Code Official. Currently some of the ICC Codes have the 20 day requirement, and Code Change Proposals have been submitted for all ICC Codes to contain this 20 day time frame.

Cost Impact: The code change proposal will not increase the cost of construction.
