The next meeting of the A117 Committee is scheduled for September 16-20, 2002. The meeting will be held at the Washington Plaza Hotel in downtown (NW) Washington, DC, located at Thomas Circle, NW.

The main agenda item is the consideration and Committee Action on Public Comments submitted on the 2003 edition of ICC/ANSI A117.1 *Standard on Accessible and Useable Buildings and Facilities*.

Lodging rooms have also been reserved for this event at the Washington Plaza Hotel. The room rate is \$129.00 single, or \$159.00 double occupancy, plus 14.5% tax per night. The rooms have been blocked starting the night of September 15th through the 20th.
