ICC Standard on Manufacturing Housing Construction and Safety

- Call for Public Proposals Extended -

The period of time for Public Proposals for revisions to ICC/ANSI 2.0-1998 Manufactured Housing and Construction and Safety Standards (MHCSS) has been extended. The basis for Public Proposals is the 1998 edition of the ICC MHCSS. In addition to the provisions currently contained in the 1998 edition, the content of this standard will be expanded to include provisions on the installation of manufactured homes.

Proposals are now due November 15, 2004

Proposals are now due to ICC on or before November 15, 2004. ICC prefers to receive all submittals of Public Proposals and Public Comments as a document(s) attached to an e-mail.
