



## CP #26-05 Honorary Membership

This policy establishes the process for nominating Honorary Member candidates for presentation to the ICC membership at the Annual Business Meeting and is in accordance with section 2.1.3.4 of the ICC Bylaws.

**1.0 Nomination:** Annually, the Board of Directors shall propose to the ICC Governmental Member Representatives in attendance at the Annual Business Meeting of the organization, nominees for Honorary Member status. Nominees shall be brought forward by the Board of Directors after consideration of the recommendations of the Honorary Member Nominating Committee.

**2.0 Qualifications:** In accordance with the ICC Bylaws, to be considered for nomination as an Honorary Member, the nominee(s) shall have rendered outstanding service to the ICC or one of the legacy model code organizations, such as departing board members or officers.

**3.0 Number:** The number of Honorary Member nominees nominated each year shall be limited to not more than five.

**4.0 Committee:** Each year the President shall appoint a committee of the Board consisting of not less than three (3) members of the Board. The President shall designate one of the committee members to act as Chair.

**4.1** The Committee shall bring forward their recommended nominees not less than 60 days prior to the Annual Business Meeting.

**4.2** A call for nominations shall be made each year along with the announcement for other ICC Awards.

**5.0 Ratification:** During the Annual Business Meeting the proposed Honorary Member nominees shall be presented to the Governmental Member Representatives for ratification. To be considered as Honorary Members, the Board slate of nominees must be ratified by a simple majority of the Governmental Member Representatives present.

**6.0 Benefits:** Honorary Members shall be entitled to the same ICC member benefits as are provided to Associate Members plus other privileges, as provided by the ICC Bylaws.
