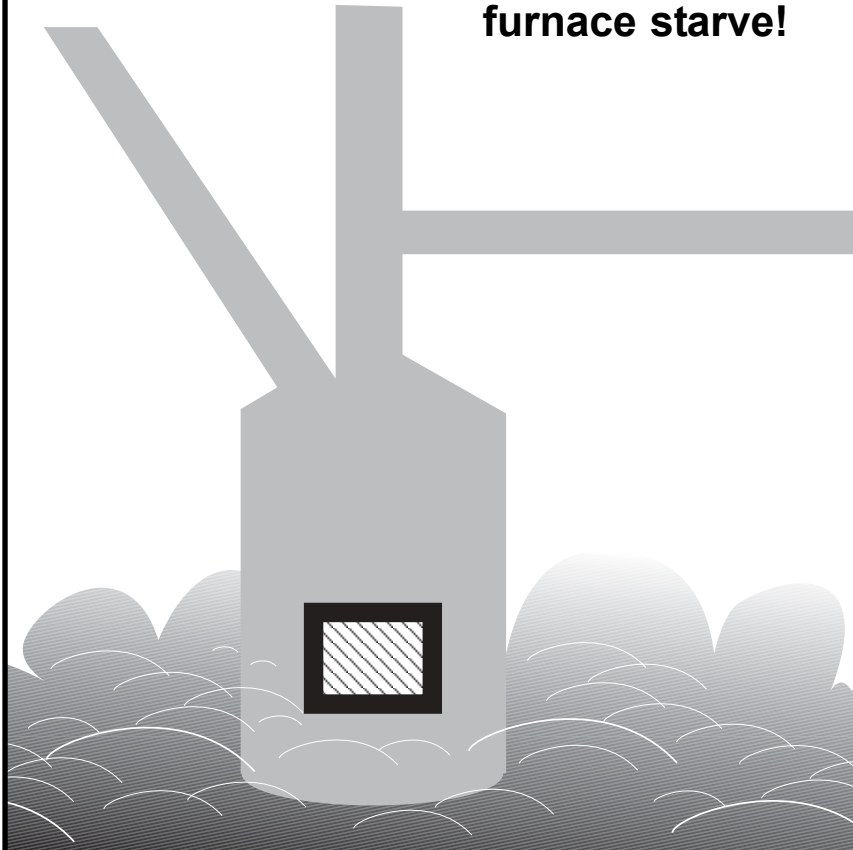




TIPS FROM THE BUILDING INSPECTOR

**Don't let your
furnace starve!**



If your gas furnace does not get enough air to properly burn fuel, it will starve. This allows partially burned fuel and carbon monoxide to infiltrate back into your home causing illness—or even death.
