Eligibility

Code Enforcement Employees

Applicants for most scholarships shall be children (as defined below) of code enforcement agency personnel. The jurisdictional authority must be an active Governmental Member of the International Code Council. (Please see note below.)

• <u>Children (Definition)</u>

Children must be dependents as defined by the Internal Revenue Service. Typically, this includes birth children, stepchildren, legally adopted children, or a legal ward financially supported by the employee.

Note: The William J. Tangye scholarship is available to children of all active ICC members; however, the applicant must be enrolled in Engineering, Architecture or Construction Technology programs. Also, some of the ICC Chapters prefer candidates from their home states; however, it is not a mandatory requirement.
