1. What are the leadership capabilities that will continue to strengthen the Chapters and ICC?
2. What are the common key issues that we need to focus on to move forward together?

For Example:

- b. Identify what can be accomplished vs. what cannot.
- c. Will your Chapter's Vision, Mission and goals sustain you for the next 5 years and beyond? Do you need new goals?
- d. How can we engage the next generation of ICC Chapter members?
- e. How could we share best practices across Chapters?
- f. How could we create an individualized development plan for each Chapter?
- g. Code Adoptions—how could we improve consistency and uniformity?
