CHAPTER 9 CHANGE OF OCCUPANCY

912.4.1 Means of egress for change to higher hazard category. When a change of occupancy classification is made to a higher hazard category (lower number) as shown in Table 912.4, the means of egress shall comply with the requirements of Chapter 10 of the *International Building Code*.

Exceptions: (no change to Exceptions 1, 2, 3, 5, 6 and 7)

4. Existing corridor wall constructed of both sides of wood lath and plaster in good condition or 1/2-inch thick (12.7 mm) gypsum wallboard shall be permitted. Such walls shall either terminate at the underside of a ceiling of equivalent construction or extend to the underside of the floor or roof next above.
