On Page 3 under the section heading "Code Points", For the Compliance Section (IECC Section 101.5 through 101.3.5) the language should be changed to read as follows

- Code Compliance Process is as follows
 - Determine if the project must comply with the IECC or is the building exempt.
 - Low Energy buildings are exempt from the <u>thermal envelope</u> requirements of this code.
 - Those with a peak rate of energy usage less than 3.4 Btu/h per square foot for space conditioning purposes are exempt <u>from the thermal envelope</u> <u>requirements of this code</u>.
 - Those with a peak rate of energy usage less than 1 watt per square foot for space conditioning purposes are exempt <u>from the thermal envelope</u> <u>requirements of this code</u>.
 - Is the designer using the IECC or ASHREA for a commercial building (see section 501)

On Page 5 under the section heading "Code Points" for Low Energy Buildings (IECC Section 101.5.2), the language should be changed to read as follows

- Buildings designated as exempt include buildings that use less than 1 watt/ft2 or 3.4 Btu/h ft2 for space conditioning are exempt from thermal envelope requirements of this code.
- Buildings, or portions thereof, that are not conditioned <u>are exempt from thermal envelope</u> requirements of this code.
