

## May 22-26, 2017 | University of Texas at Arlington

The International Code Council's (ICC's) **Training and Certification Summit**, May 22–26, 2017 (TCS 2017) will be held at the University of Texas at Arlington. Held in conjunction with the 25th Building Professional Institute (BPI) educational program, ICC's Summit will provide four unique education tracks offered over a three day period. Then, on the fourth day, the certification track will culminate with an opportunity to take the corresponding ICC Certification exam. Additional certification exams will also be available.

Training for each track will be provided by ICC's national experts. This event is being positioned as a great opportunity to sharpen one's skills, expand one's code knowledge and help advance their career. In addition to being aligned with our Board's directives to expand leadership development opportunities and develop the next generation of code officials including guidance on mentoring, the tracks are designed to meet the most critical training needs of professionals from across the country.

- Residential Building Inspector Certification Academy
- The Multigenerational Communications in the Workplace Institute

Special bundle pricing will be available on ICC's references and study guides to help participants to prepare to take the Certification exams and will provide an additional revenue stream for the event.
