



ICC Call for Committees – Codes & Standards related

With the upcoming 2019 Group B Public Comment Hearings starting on October 23rd, to be followed by the Online Governmental Consensus Vote, the 2018/2019 Cycle of Code Development is winding down. That means it's time to start gearing up for the 2021/2022 Cycle!

The terms for committee members on the 5 Code Action Committees (BCAC, FCAC, PMGCAC, SEHPCAC and the CCAC) and staggered terms for certain Codes and Standards Council (CSC) members expire on December 31, 2019. There is also a Regulator vacancy on the Committee on Healthcare. While 2020 will not see any code development hearings, it will still be a busy year for the next round of CAC appointments and the CSC as they will be preparing for the 2021 Cycle of code development.

In January of 2020, there will be another Call for Committee for the remaining 2021/2022 Cycle committees, namely: Code Development, Interpretation and the Code Correlating Committee. The application deadline will be June 1, 2020.

Volunteers are one of the most important assets of the International Code Council. Their work on the ICC Board of Directors, committees and councils is directly related to the success of ICC. It takes the time and expertise of many individuals working through the numerous ICC committees to shape the Code Council into the world-class membership organization that exists today.

This "Call for Committee" provides another opportunity to serve. Below are the specific Calls for Committee for the CAC's and the CSC.

Technical Code Action Committees: Technical Code Action Committees are code discipline specific committees whose purpose is to identify opportunities to improve and enhance a particular International Code or portion thereof. This is accomplished by the CAC's submitting proposed code changes, modifications and public comments as well as participating in the Committee Action and Public Comment Hearings. At this time, ICC is receiving applications for members for the four technical CAC's listed below. The current CAC members whose term expire December 31, 2019 must reapply to be considered for re-appointment. Applications for CAC committee appointments will be reviewed by the Codes and Standards Council who is responsible for making recommendations to the ICC Board who makes the final appointment decision. - BCAC** Building Code Action Committee. Primary responsibility is: IBC Chapters 1-6, 10-13, 15-25, and 27-35; IEBC; IPMC; IRC Chapters 1-10; IZC
- FCAC** Fire Code Action Committee. Primary responsibility is: IBC Chapters 7, 8, 9, 14 and 26; IFC; ICC Performance Code; IWUIC
- PMGCAC** Plumbing, Mechanical and Fuel Gas Code Action Committee. Primary responsibility is: IFGC, IMC, IPC, IPSDC; IRC Chapters 12 -33; ISPSC
- SEHPCAC** Sustainability, Energy & High Performance Building Code Action Committee (IECC, IgCC and Chapter 11 of the IRC)

Travel required. The CAC's typically hold 3, two-day joint meetings per year. ICC Governmental Member Representatives are authorized to travel at ICC's expense when participating at CAC meetings. All others are responsible for funding their participation on this committee. The CAC's also conduct business via conference calls. As in past cycles, the PMGCAC will conduct all its business via conference calls.

Compliance Code Action Committee (ES/IAC/SRCC): The Compliance Code Action Committee (CCAC) was first implemented for the 2018/2019 Cycle. The purpose of this CAC is to monitor and participate in code development and standard development activities to support the subsidiary organizations, primarily ICC Evaluation Service (ES), International Accreditation Service (IAS) and the Solar Rating & Certification Corporation (SRCC) of the International Code Council and to pursue opportunities to improve and enhance code content and standard development on behalf of the subsidiary operations. This activity includes submitting proposed code changes, modifications and public comments as well as participating in the Committee Action and Public Comment Hearings. All work of this committee will be coordinated with the other ICC committees, such as the current CAC's, to avoid conflicts and minimize duplication. The CCAC is regulated by [Council Policy 48](#).

At this time, ICC is receiving applications for members for the CCAC. The current CCAC members whose term expire December 31, 2019 must reapply to be considered for re-appointment. Applications for committee appointments will be reviewed by the Codes and Standards Council who is responsible for making recommendations to the ICC Board who makes the final appointment decision. CCAC Compliance Code Action Committee

The CCAC will conduct business primarily via conference calls. However, in the event that an in-person meeting is required, ICC Governmental Member Representatives are authorized to travel at ICC's expense. All others are responsible for funding their participation on this committee.

The committee develops proposed code changes, modifications and public comments as well as participates in the Committee Action and Public Comment Hearings in an effort to develop the most contemporary, effective and efficient provisions for hospital and ambulatory care facilities to assure the highest level of safety for all users of such facilities.
