



Eligible voters for the 2021 Public Comment Hearings and Online Governmental Consensus Vote

Due process and transparency are fundamental tenets in the code development process. The Code Council's position is that of a neutral facilitator with a responsibility to protect voter privacy. Recognizing the need to provide an enhanced level of transparency in the process, for the 2019 Cycle the Code Council Board of Directors decided to provide additional data which included a snapshot of the number of eligible voters for the Public Comment Hearings and Online Governmental Vote on a state-by-state basis. This document provides such data for the 2021 Cycle.
