



# Path to Code Official Safety Credential of Learning Achievement (COS-CLA)



## STEP 1

Go to the website of the CEOSF: <https://www.codeofficersafety.org> purchase and complete the training of the five-module COSS <https://www.codeofficersafety.org/training>

## STEP 2

Go to the ICC website and sign into your MYICC page; go through the purchase process of COS-CLA, part of which will be uploading your certificate of course completion of the five-module COSS training. (See Note 1)

## STEP 3

Purchase, take and pass ICC online proctored COS-CLA assessment

## STEP 4

COS-CLA issued; good for 3 years (See Note 2)

**Note 1:** If you do not already have an ICC account, you will need to create one at this link <https://www.iccsafe.org/register>

**Note 2:** After 3 years from issuance of the CLA, a minimum 3-hour training on the subject of code official safety offered by ICC or CEOSF will be required to renew the COS-CLA
