



# Firestopping

## Credential of Learning Achievement

Participants will gain an understanding of the importance of firestopping and its role in fire and smoke containment resulting in improved occupant and building safety. Related codes, standards, and testing requirements will be presented as well as plan review, inspection techniques, products, correct product applications, and tips and techniques. Upon completion, you will be equipped with a CLA credential that may be relied upon by building and safety departments, fire departments and by the construction industry to guide communities' firestopping related plan review, inspection and administration.

### PREREQUISITES

A. UL, FM, IFC, or WABO: Firestop Industry Formal Examination -or-  
B. ICC: Commercial Building Inspector - B2, Building Plans Examiner - B3, Building Inspector - B5, Combination Plan Examiner - C3, Combination Inspector - C8, Master Code Professional - MCP, or any ICC Special Inspector -or-  
C. OSHPD: CA Hospital Inspector Certification Class A, B, or C.

### TRAINING

The 8-hour Firestopping (Includes 2 Parts) training supports this CLA and is available as a self-paced training module.

### EXAM

The exam is 30 questions, based on the required training and references. To pass the exam you must receive a score of 80% or higher. You will have unlimited test retakes and there is no time limit. The test must be taken within a year of purchase of the CLA.
