Participants learn specialized knowledge on the role of the building department in the wake of a disaster, techniques on how to operate within disaster environments and techniques on how to perform Post-disaster Building Safety Evaluations. Training will include instruction on identifying and evaluating damage through case studies and activities that walk participants through disaster scenarios, encourage discussion, and provide direction on documentation. Upon achievement of this CLA, you can be relied on by communities to assist with performing post-disaster building safety evaluations and contribute to the safety and recovery of a community struck by disaster.

PREREQUISITES	Completion of ICC's When Disaster Strikes - Evaluator course.
TRAINING	The 7-hour When Disaster Strikes Evaluator training is required for this CLA and is available as a self-paced and live training.
EXAM	The exam is 30 questions, based on the required training and references. To pass the exam you must receive a score of 75% or higher. You will have unlimited test retakes and there is no time limit. The test must be taken within a year of purchase of the CLA.
