Having been brought up to speed by the Greater Fort Worth Builders Association about the proposed change of moving code development away from a government consensus model to something more akin to ANSI's process, I would like to record my vote of support for this move.

The committee based process will improve the speed of code generation as well as approvals. It will also allow stakeholders a better opportunity to provide direct input and shield the process from outside influences more susceptible to ulterior motives or lacking relevant background to inform the process.
