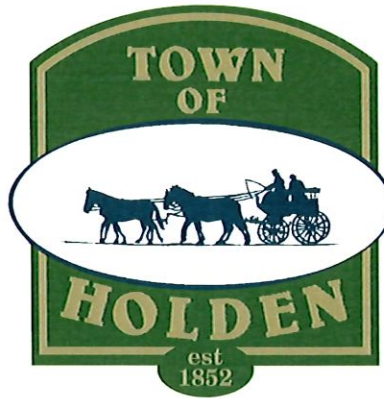

Chair Spencer:

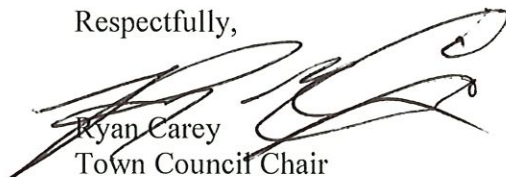
