Where adopted by the jurisdiction, the ~~The~~ following codes shall be considered part of the requirements of this code: the *International Building Code*, the *International Code Council Performance Code*® (ICCPC®), the *International Energy Conservation Code*® (IECC®), the *International Existing Building Code*® (IEBC®), the *International Fire Code*® (IFC®), the *International Fuel Gas Code*® (IFGC®), the *International Mechanical Code*® (IMC®), the *International Plumbing Code*® (IPC®), *International Property Maintenance Code*® (IPMC®), and the *International Residential Code*® (IRC®).

Reason: The provisions of the other International Codes can only be enforced if adopted by the appropriate jurisdiction. Without this qualifying statement the language of this section is misleading and could result in regulatory confusion.

Cost Impact: Will not increase the cost of construction.
