

# Codes, Standard, and Guideline Committee Position Types

	Membership Type	Role/Description
Main Committee Members	Main Committee Members are approved and assigned to committees by the Board of Directors and serve a specified term limit.	
	Voting Member	Has full rights to participate in discussions, propose motions, and cast votes on decisions made by the full committee.
	Alternate Member	<i>Applies only to standards development committees.</i> Designated for organizational memberships; may vote only when the primary organizational representative is absent.
	Non-Voting Member	<i>Applies only to standards development committees.</i> Contributes specific subject matter expertise to support the committee; participates in discussions, may propose motions, but does not vote.
	Subgroup Member	<i>Applies only to standards and guideline development committees.</i> Participates in a specific subgroup or task force; has voting rights within that assigned subgroup. Appointed by the main committee.
	Interested Party (IP)	Interested Parties are self identified by filling out the online IP form. These individuals cannot propose motions or cast votes on committee decisions. However, these individuals may actively participate in the standards/code development process by attending committee meetings and providing input during discussions.
	Contingent Member	A pre-approved individual designated by the Board of Directors to serve as a voting member in the event the primary voting member is no longer able to serve on the committee.
