Good morning. As an online voter, I am writing to strongly urge you to please uphold **ALL** of the provisions we overwhelmingly passed in the 2021 IECC that have been subject to ongoing appeals, especially the electric vehicle provisions.

I would also like to express my sincerest gratitude for the online voting process and the opportunity to vote. I am greatly concerned about the proposal for live voting during the hearings as the hearings often are equivalent to over a week's worth of work time, which many interested parties simply cannot accommodate. Allowing voters to continue to vote online and view videos on their own time greatly increases access and equity. I am quite hopeful that the Validation Committee will follow through on the results of the independent audit report and that the Board will continue to support processes that allow for ease of participation in future codes cycles.
