

Michael Pfeiffer is the Senior Vice President of Technical Services at the International Code Council (ICC). Within his role, he oversees the Codes and Standards as well as the Architectural and Engineering Services Departments at ICC.

The Codes and Standards Department is an integral part of the strategic mission of the ICC, which is to provide the highest quality codes, standards, products and services for all concerned with the safety and performance of the built environment. This includes both the development and maintenance of the International Codes (I-Codes) as well as ICC Standards.

The Architectural and Engineering Services Department is responsible for all technical support services provided by ICC. This includes providing interpretations of the I-Codes (over 54,000 annually), Plan Review services and providing Training and Education services.

Prior to his position as Senior Vice President of Technical Services, Michael was the lead structural design engineer for Black & Veatch. He also worked for Building Officials and Code Administrators International, Inc. (BOCA), one of the founding companies of ICC. During his tenure, Michael worked up the ranks from staff engineer to Vice President.
