On behalf of the Oregon Permit Technicians Association (OPTA), I am writing to support the nomination of the following nominees to the ICC Board of Directors:

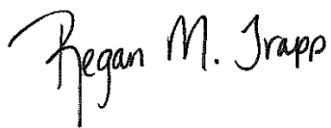
