## The International Code Council Presents at COP26 to Highlight Key Role of Building Codes and Standards in Achieving Climate Resilience

As countries gather in Glasgow this week to address the current climate crisis, The International Code Council provides expertise and solutions for governments and the building sector.

**Washington, D.C.** – The International Code Council, a member of the Global Alliance for Buildings and Construction (GlobalABC) and the #BuildingtoCOP26 Coalition, will be presenting at COP26 this week. The work of the Code Council and these groups, comprised of business and government networks focused on sustainability in the built environment, is to spotlight a building's potential in accelerating the response to a changing climate.
