- The renewal will be voided
- The credential(s) will revert to their previous status
- Renewal fees are non-refundable

- Renewing the individual certifications does not automatically renew the Combination Designation itself.
- Holding certification or renewing certification in the “General” Inspection category does not qualify you to automatically receive certification in the “Residential” and/or “Commercial” Inspection categories.
