Ryan M. Colker is the vice president of innovation at the International Code Council, where he identifies emerging issues in the building industry, including how new technologies can be leveraged by codes and standards, methods to modernize the application of building regulations, and the development of new business strategies that support members and

building safety professionals. He also serves as executive director of the Alliance for National and Community Resilience.

Most recently, Colker was Vice President of the National Institute of Building Sciences (NIBS), where he led the Institute's efforts to improve the built environment through the collaboration of industry stakeholders from both the public and private sectors.
