
Historical Highlights



- 2004: ICC offers Certification Exam services to selected Canadian Provinces
- 2005: ICC and the IRCC publish International Fire Engineering Guidelines
- 2007: Saudi Arabia signs agreement to publish the Saudi Building Code based on 2003/2006 I-Codes
- 2013: ICC publishes Abu Dhabi codes based on 2009 I-Codes with supporting services







Historical Highlights



- 2016: Agreement with GSO to publish the Gulf Building Code (GBC) based on 2015 I-Codes
- 2016: Mexico IECC published based on 2012 International Energy Conservation Code

Project Completion



- Its never done...
- Go live, couple of weeks of no critical/environmental changes...tweaks ok
- The platform has to be "solid" before you sign off
- Train, Train, Train

Acceptance



- Runs well with no major changes
- Resistance to accept change by end user.
 They have to realize their platform has changed and get use to it
