# Proclamation

**WHEREAS**, Orange County Government's continuing efforts to address critical issues of building safety and sustainability in the developmental environment that affects our residents, both in everyday life and in times of natural disaster, give us confidence that our structures are safe and sound; and

**WHEREAS**, Building Safety Month recognizes the building safety and fire prevention officials, architects, engineers, builders, tradespeople, design professionals, laborers, plumbers, and others in the construction industry who work year-round to ensure the safe construction of buildings; and

**WHEREAS**, Building Safety Month is sponsored by the International Code Council to remind the public about the critical role of our communities' largely unknown protectors of public safety—our local code officials, who ensure that our buildings are safe, sustainable, and affordable, all of which are essential elements that contribute to our community's prosperity; and

**WHEREAS**, this year's Building Safety Month theme, "Game On," focuses on raising awareness about building safety and the importance of building codes and strong code enforcement; and

**WHEREAS**, in observance of Building Safety Month, residents are asked to consider projects that improve building safety and sustainability at home and in the community and to acknowledge the essential services provided by local and state building departments, fire prevention bureaus, and federal agencies in protecting lives and property.

**NOW, THEREFORE**, I, Jerry L. Demings, by the authority vested in me as Orange County Mayor, do hereby proclaim the month of May 2025, as
