

**A PROCLAMATION
BY
THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF
FORSYTH COUNTY, GEORGIA**

WHEREAS, Forsyth County is committed to recognizing that our growth and strength depend on the safety and essential role our homes, buildings, and infrastructure play, both in everyday life and when disasters strike; and,

WHEREAS, modern building codes and standards include safeguards to protect the public from hazards such as hurricanes, snowstorms, tornadoes, wildland fires, floods, and earthquakes; and,

WHEREAS, confidence in the resilience of homes, buildings, and infrastructure is achieved through the commitment of dedicated Forsyth County officials and private partners, who work year-round to ensure the safe construction of buildings, including building safety and fire prevention personnel, planners, architects, engineers, builders, tradespeople, design professionals, laborers, plumbers, and others in the construction industry; and,

WHEREAS, Forsyth County is a member of the International Code Council, a nonprofit that brings together local, state, territorial, tribal, and federal officials who are experts in the built environment to create and implement the highest-quality codes and standards for buildings; and,

WHEREAS, the purpose of BUILDING SAFETY MONTH is to remind the public about the critical role of our communities' largely unknown protectors of public safety, who assure us of safe, sustainable, and affordable buildings that are essential to prosperity.

NOW THEREFORE AND BE IT RESOLVED, the Forsyth County Board of Commissioners does hereby proclaim the month of May, 2026, as BUILDING SAFETY MONTH and encourages all citizens to raise awareness about building safety on a personal, local, and global scale.
