RESOLUTION

PROCLAIMING MAY OF 2026 AS BUILDING SAFETY MONTH

WHEREAS, Madison County, Alabama is committed to recognizing that its growth and strength depend on the safety and economic values of homes, buildings and infrastructure that serve Madison County's citizens, both in everyday life and in times of disaster; and

WHEREAS, confidence in the resilience of the buildings that make up Madison County's community is achieved through the devotion of building safety and fire prevention officials, architects, engineers, builders, tradespeople, design professionals, laborers, plumbers and many others in the construction industry, who work to ensure the safe construction of buildings; and

WHEREAS, dedicated members of the International Code Council, a nonprofit organization, bring together local, state and federal officials to create and implement the highest-quality codes which protect the citizens of Madison County in the buildings where they live, learn, work and play; and

WHEREAS, Building Safety Month is sponsored by the International Code Council to remind the public about the critical role of local code officials, who assure safe, sustainable, energy efficient and livable buildings that are essential to prosperity in Madison County and throughout the United States; and

WHEREAS, "Built to Last," the theme for Building Safety Month 2026, encourages all citizens to raise awareness about the importance of building safety on a personal, local and global scale; and

WHEREAS, each year, in observance of Building Safety Month, people all over the world are asked to consider the commitment to improve building safety, resilience and economic investment at home and in the community, and to acknowledge the essential service provided to all by local, state, tribal, territorial and federal building safety and fire prevention departments and agencies, in protecting lives and property.
