The Jeffco Division of [Building Safety](#) is proud to announce its fifth Master Code Professional (MCP). Andre Jaen, building inspector, earned the gold standard of MCP in March. The MCP designation is the pinnacle for building safety professionals and demonstrates a commitment to public safety, diverse knowledge of construction safety codes and self-initiative.

Nationwide there are more than 700 individuals who have attained this high-level of achievement, however, there are only 19 in the state of Colorado. "We are proud to have such dedicated individuals serving Jefferson County," said Jeanie Rossillon, director of Development and Transportation.

To become a MCP, a candidate must first earn eight core International Code Council (ICC) certifications plus an additional number of elective ICC certifications. Typical Master Code Professionals hold 17 or more professional certifications.

For the five building safety employees, this accomplishment included demonstrating knowledge on topics beyond the scope of their work. "The more we know, the better we can help our customers," said Becky Baker, director of Building Safety.
